## Playhouse After School COVID-19 Health & Safety

### **General Guidelines**

- All class materials are thoroughly cleaned, and procedures utilize CDC-approved disinfecting solutions.
- Students should not attend class if they show symptoms of or have tested positive for COVID-19.
- If a child tests positive for COVID-19 the child must isolate for a minimum of 5 days from the onset of symptoms. The child may rejoin class five days after testing positive with the initial positive test or first symptom date counting as day zero and symptoms have abated. However, children must mask on days 6-10.

# **During Class**

- Students are suggested to bring a pre-filled water bottle for class.
- Students will not be permitted to share any food or drinks.
- If your child's class includes a proctored snack break, please pack a snack in your child's backpack. We request **no peanuts** in any snacks, for the safety of the children who may have allergies.

# **COVID – 19 Close Contact Contingencies**

- If your child has tested positive for COVID-19, you must notify Playhouse staff and we will notify parents/guardians of close contacts. Informing your child's school nurse does not guarantee that Playhouse will be notified. Please contact Julia Gomez, Education Associate, at julia.gomez@cincyplay.com if your child has tested positive.
- An individual is considered to be a close contact with someone testing positive for COVID-19 if they have been within less than 3-6 feet of the individual for 15 minutes or more OR they have had direct physical contact with the individual.
- Close contacts will be required to mask for 10 full days. Day 0 is the day of your last exposure to someone with COVID-19. **Day 1 is the first full day** after your last exposure.
