Add a workshop or residency to your student matinee experience, either at the theatre or at your school. Workshops and residencies deepen learning around our plays and in core subjects. Teachers have the option of scheduling one to five sessions with each session lasting 45 to 50 minutes. Programs meet CCSS.ELA-'Literacy and Speaking' and 'Listening' standards and can be adapted for grades 1 to 12.







BRINGING PLAYS TO LIFE

Our five-session residencies engage students in the power of collaborative storytelling by examining scenes and themes of the play. This interactive process culminates in a retelling of the story. Choose from three styles of residency: Dramatic Interpretation, Creative Lens, and Public Speaking. Residencies take place at your school.

PRE- AND POST-SHOW WORKSHOPS

Pre-show workshops prepare your students for a morning at the theatre, introducing them to pivotal characters and themes of the play. Post-show workshops reflect on the play, encouraging your students to think deeper about the play's message and plot. Each of these one-session workshops can be booked separately or in tandem. Pre-show workshops take place at your school. Post-show workshops can take place at your school or at the theatre after your performance, based on availability.

ENRICHMENT WORKSHOPS

In these one-session workshops, students will learn the basics of theater arts specialties while connecting with aspects of the story for the chosen play. Choose from three different workshop styles: Actor's Toolbox, Designers Viewpoint, and Public Speaking. Enrichment workshops can take place at your school or at the theatre after your performance, based on availability, and can be paired with a backstage tour of the theater.
